

## *Admission Criteria*

Before being accepted into the EH training program, all applicants will have an interview to ensure that they meet the following criteria:

1. Documentation of a disability that presents a barrier to getting or keeping a job.
2. The individual is being referred by the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, school system or another appropriate government or private agency which purchases services on your behalf.
3. Minimum age of entry is sixteen. "Working papers" are required if you are between the ages of sixteen and eighteen.
4. For purposes of federal immigration law, you will be required to provide EH with documentary evidence of your identity and eligibility for employment in the U.S. It must be provided to us within 3 days of your start date.
5. The ability to perform minimal daily living skills such as required in restrooms, lunchroom and for self-medication. The need for an aide for such living skills can be reviewed individually.
6. The ability to secure reliable and consistent transportation to and from the program.
7. Consistently maintain behavior that is not disruptive or dangerous to you or to others.
8. No current alcohol abuse or use of illegal substances will be tolerated.
9. Express a desire to be enrolled in the program and have the basic skills to benefit from EH services.
