#### **Programs**

Program highlights in 2024 include:

- Our youth transition to employment RISE program provided intensive services to 56 young adults and referred 28 individuals for additional employmentrelated services through Employment Horizons




#### **Business Services**

Business highlights in 2024 include:


- Program participants employed at EH earned \$2.74 million in earned income
